Clinical Therapist

Family Ark provides individual, family, and group therapy services to youth and families in southern Indiana. The Clinical Therapist provides therapeutic interventions in the home, community or office setting, conducts assessments of environmental factors in the home impacting child safety, and collaborates with team members, schools, families and other professionals to meet each child's specific goals and needs. This individual also works with court-involved youth to address behavioral health needs. This position reports to the Clinical Director.

Key Responsibilities Include:

- Facilitates individual, family and group therapy.
- Provides treatment support to the Case Managers to enhance team and program effectiveness.
- Maintains all client case records by documenting client contacts, as well as contacts with referral sources, schools, parents, and other professionals.
- Develops treatment plans, revises treatment plans quarterly and writes and submits monthly reports to referral sources.
- Participates in case conferences and court proceedings as necessary for client care.

Minimum Requirements:

- Master's degree in social work, psychology, counseling, or related field.
- 2 years of like social service experience in his/her respective discipline.
- Professional clinical licensure (i.e., LMHC, LMFT, LCSW, etc.) required. Associate level licensure will be considered.
- Ability to assess and coordinate the treatment needs for complex family systems.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills.
- Ability to interact effectively with people from diverse social and economic backgrounds.
